Dear DAVID D HACK:

The Agent Orange Veteran Payment Program has received and reviewed your application for disability payments and found that you meet the criteria that the Court established for eligibility. Accordingly, your application for disability payments has been approved.

Shortly, under separate cover, you will receive your total award in the amount of \$1834.67. This payment was calculated based upon a schedule established by the Court. Under the schedule established by the Court, payments are based upon the length of time you have been disabled and your age at the time of "total disability". In calculating your payment, the Agent Orange Veteran Payment Program determined that you became "totally disabled" on 05/01/1991.

You may appeal the Payment Programs' Decision

YOU HAVE 60 DAYS FROM RECEIPT OF THIS LETTER TO FILE AN APPEAL. FAILURE TO APPEAL THIS DETERMINATION WITHIN THIS TIME PERIOD FORFEITS YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL.

You have the right to appeal this decision in any respect. To initiate an appeal, you should send a letter to:
